

ENROLMENT

- It's free and without age limit
- It's necessary to show a document (identity card or driving licence) and your Fiscal Code
- Parental authorization, through a special form, is necessary for minors

CONSULTATION IN THE LIBRARY

It's possible to consult books, newspapers and magazines (they are 135, 4 of which are foreign written in English, French and Spanish) inside the library's rooms also without being enrolled.

BOOK LOANS

- Book loans are free
- Book loans, not more than 30, last 30 days
- Periodicals, except the latest issue, can be borrowed for 7 days; newspapers and local magazines cannot be borrowed
- It's possible to renew the loan, even by telephone, for other 30 days if the book hasn't been reserved
- Board game loans (not more than 1) last 30 days
- Multimedia, not more than 10, loans last 7 days and can be renewed for other 7 days
- Dictionaries, encyclopedias, atlases and multi-volume works can't be loaned

INTERLIBRARY LOANS

- The books of the other libraries can be found and reserved by consulting the catalogue at the web site <http://rbv.biblioteche.it>
- If the book is available, it will be delivered to our library within about one week

EBOOK

You can borrow three e books a month for 14 days and you can't renew the loan. You can reserve 5 e-books. You need: 1) username (fiscal code) and password (date of birth YYYY-MM-DD) to enter the RBV catalogue rbv.biblioteche.it
2) use a reading software (for pc "Adobe digital Edition", for iPhone and iPad "MLOL reader" or "Blufire", for smartphone and tablet "MLOL Reader" or "Adiko")

CATALOGUE

You can find the books you are interested in by consulting the catalogue at the web site: <http://rbv.biblioteche.it>

You have to log by your fiscal code and by your password, that is your date of birth written YYYY-MM-DD. You can reserve the books by yourself from home. In the library there are 4 pcs where you can consult the catalogue. The librarians can help you to consult the catalogue and to find the books in the shelves.

INTERNET

- The Internet service is reserved to registered members of the library. Minors need the authorization of their parents. 6 computers are available for internet surfing, to write documents, to print, to watch DVDs and to listen to music CDs
- It's possible to use a computer for not over 2 hours and with only four logins a day
- The internet service is free
- The wi-fi system is available in the area of the library and in the reading park

MUNICIPAL HISTORICAL ARCHIVE PHOTOGRAPHIC ARCHIVE

The historical archive of Valdagno Municipality can be consulted in the library on request. The photographic archive of the Great War composed of about 700 photos, which come from a private foundation, is preserved in the library and it's consultable on request.

BORN TO READ AND BORN FOR MUSIC

Born to read it's a national project (www.natiperleggere.it) for reading to children from the 6th month of life. The library provides informative material. It also lends thirty books a month to some pediatricians that can be borrowed from the clinic they work in. Furthermore, each new father who goes to the demographic services to report his child's birth is given a welcome letter from the Mayor, in which he is invited to take the child right away to the library to get the loan card and to receive a book as a gift (*Milky Words* project). *Born for music* is a national project (www.natiperlamusica.org) that promotes the musical experience in family as a relationship tool for a better development of the child in the early stages of life, even during pregnancy. The library offers a section of Born for Music themed books, in addition to informative material and a bibliography.

THE SEED LIBRARY

It is a cultural project aimed at the promotion of the culture of the ground, active citizenship, knowledge and respect for the environment. Borrow the seeds, take them home and plant them. Water, take care of the growing seedling and then, when ripe, return part of the new seeds.

NOVELTY LIST

A fortnightly booklet, listing the titles of new books acquired is available (also on the web site).

AREAS OF THE LIBRARY

Piano terra

Summer room: philosophy, psychology, religion, economics, politics, law, science, arts and sports, DVDs, VHS, music CDs .

Winter room: history, geography, atlases and travel guides, foreign books.

Autumn room: novels, audiobooks, dictionaries and language courses.

Spring room: this is the children's section

Reading and study room

It's on the second floor. There are 52 seats with individual illumination to study, read and use a portable computer.

Fireplace room

It's in the basement and it's a meeting point, where you can have some refreshment from machines.

Reading Park

It's a park with comfortable seats and some notice-boards with excerpts of books.

THE LIBRARY OUTDOOR

30 books that can be consulted or borrowed are made available by the library every month at two hairdressers, at one pediatrician, at the Hospital and at some schools.

EXCHANGE OF USED BOOKS

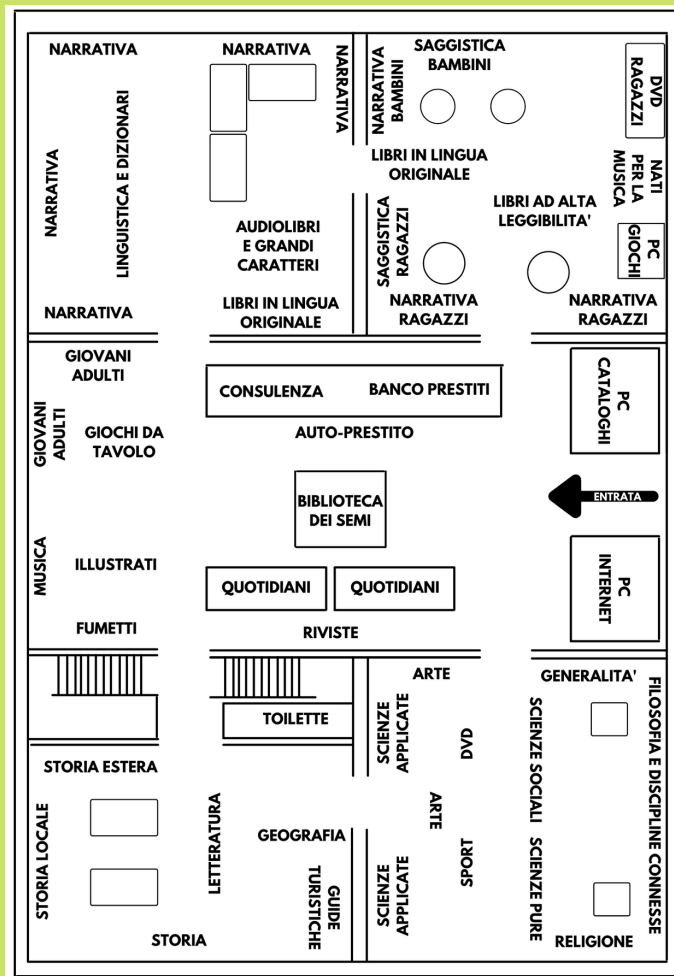
It's a point where you can exchange second-hand books. You can leave a book that you have already read and select another one.
